

**Clayton County Water Authority
Shamrock Dam Pavilion Usage Regulations /Agreement**

**2610 Shamrock Road
Jonesboro, Georgia 30236**

1. All usage must fall within the regulations of the reservoir area.
2. Reservations required for usage. Complete payment due at the time of reservation.
No refunds or rain checks
3. Maximum group size is 100 people.
4. Rental period times are final and exact. Rental groups must vacate the pavilion on or before the policy exit time.
5. Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs are prohibited.
6. Lewd, profane or offensive behavior or language is prohibited.
7. All music must be played at low levels so as not to disturb other visitors or neighbors to the area. No live bands or personal address systems.
8. Music with profanity vulgar, lewd or offensive lyrics is prohibited.
9. All trash must be neatly placed in the containers provided. Littering is prohibited.
10. All pets must be properly restrained by owners. Clayton County's Leash Law will be enforced.

As evidenced by my signature below I have read, understand and agree to abide by the regulations set for by the Clayton County Water Authority regarding usage of the Shamrock Dam Pavilion. **I also understand that failure to abide by the policies and regulations may result in the cancellation of the ongoing event and the expulsion of the rental group from the area and that payments are final with no refunds.**

Clayton County Water Authority Shamrock Dam Pavilion Regulations

The Authority's Shamrock Dam Pavilion is designed and intended to function as an outdoor recreation area for families and groups. The area is not intended for, nor will it function as, an area where political rallies, demonstrations, protest or fund raisers are held.

1. Reservations are required: No refunds or rain checks
2. Maximum group size is 100 people.
3. Alcoholic Beverages are prohibited
4. Wading, swimming or bathing is prohibited. Stay clear of the spillway and areas posted with signage.
5. Motorized vehicles on the site must be operated by a licensed driver and operated only when absolutely necessary. The use of trail bikes, go carts RTV or four wheelers is prohibited.
6. Those individuals who elect to fish from the bank must fish from within the "marked" boundaries located in the recreation area. All individuals that are fishing must comply with the State of Georgia Department of Natural Resources fishing rules and regulations. Licenses are required for ages 16 and over. No fishing from the Dam: keep off the dam slopes and rocked areas. All visitors must comply with the regulations of the area and stay within the designated and fenced public access areas.
7. All music must be played at a low level so as not to disturb other visitors or neighbors in the surrounding area. Music with profane or lewd lyrics is prohibited. No live bands. No Personal address systems or amplified sound systems.
8. No littering: trash and litter must be self-contained and disposed of properly in the containers provided.
9. Firearms, ammunition, bows, arrows, fireworks and explosives are prohibited.
10. All pets must be restrained by owners (leash law enforced in area)
11. Destruction, injury defacement, or removal of Clayton County Water Authority property is prohibited.
12. Lewd, profane or obscene language, and/or actions, are not permitted, violators will be expelled.

Failure to abide by the regulations can result in expulsion from the recreation area and cancellation of an ongoing rental event if deemed necessary by Authority Staff.
