CCWA offers a Summer Internship Program for eligible high school and college students. Candidates should have an interest in engineering, biology, drafting, environmental science or customer service.

Qualified high school candidates must be at least 16 years old, a current Junior or Senior, hold a minimum 3.0. GPA and be able to submit an official transcript.

Qualified college candidates must be at least 18 years old, hold a minimum 3.0. GPA and be able to submit an official transcript.
